

S uccessful	Reading notes reveal interpretation of the text and demonstrates an understanding of concepts through analogy and synthesis of multiple concepts. Responses are thoughtful reflections and explanations with substantiated claims and/or concrete examples. Clearly shows the reader's thought process and an understanding of the presented material, and will often make connections (with previous knowledge and across disciplines) and go beyond what is covered in the text. (2 points)
G rowing	Reading notes show growth and somewhat insightful questions, but don't show the thought process of the reader, and indicates a superficial reading of the text. (1 point)
N ot Yet	Reading notes are lacking substance and do not demonstrate thoughtful reading or interpretation of the text. Reading notes are often transcriptions of the text or equations, or comments about how interesting or "cool" something is. (0 points)
